


a tribute to late Prof. Rohini Godbole

Towards Gender equity in science -- What can institutions do?

The gender inequality in science has been globally recognised as a serious problem. In India, the gender gap in the science profession is particularly large at faculty and higher levels. Although a few individual women scientists have been working since preindependence era, the awareness of gender-based impediments for women scientists is of more recent origin. Late Prof. Rohini Godbole has played a major role in promoting gender equity in science, both at national and International level.

As a tribute to her efforts, this colloquium is organised in two parts. The first part will bring forth a brief overview of the current status of women in science and challenges in the Indian context, with some glimpses of Prof. Godbole's work in this aspect.
